

"Southampton Cave" adaptation to a pair of timber frames



Details

This adaptation to a pair of timber climbing frames provides a steel beam that spans between the two outermost corners of a pair of hinged timber climbing frames to span the gap between the top of the frames. Onto that metal support beam is fixed 3 plain 4.5" circumference climbing ropes.

This adaptation provides additional activities to increase the usefulness of a pair of timber climbing frames.

PLEASE NOTE: This is the Southampton Cave adaptation only. It is fixed to a pair of hinged frames (either hinged timber frames, or a pair of Two-in-Ones) which must be purchased separately. The price shown is to add this feature at the time of manufacture / installation of the frames and does not apply to retro-fit.
