### **MATS**



#### **SAFETY MATS**

- It is imperative that when safety mats are used, they are used as an aid to normal landing mats and are placed or secured in such a way so as to prevent the mat from slipping when in use
- 2. Mats should be handled with care to avoid damage the carrying straps are designed for carrying by two people, not for pulling the mat by one person
- 3. Safety mats should be carried by two people (and not dragged along the floor) and should be transported and stored using suitable mat trolleys.
- 4. Do not drag or fold mats as this causes excessive wear check them regularly for any damage or tears.
- 5. Mats should be cleaned regularly with mild detergent and a damp cloth to maintain their performance.

#### **MATS WITH A CARPET SURFACE**

- 1. Store flat whenever possible
- If rolling the mat for storage, the mat MUST be rolled with the carpet surface OUTSIDE
  - failure to do this may result in de-lamination of the surface of the mat which will invalidate your warranty. We recommend purchasing storage creels from Continental for rollable mats that are stored regularly while rolled-up.
- 3. Should the latex base of your mat (if applicable) gather dirt the anti-slip qualities will be impaired to restore wipe with a damp cloth to remove any dust.

### LYTAMATS AND POLYBLEND MATS

- 1. If space is limited these mats may be stored in a vertical mat trolley
- 2. Should the latex base of your mat gather dirt the anti-slip qualities will be lessened
- 3. To restore wipe with a damp cloth to remove the dirt

## **WALL AND COLUMN PADDING**

1. Padding may be cleaned with a mild detergent and damp cloth
